



Monodora grandidieri

Family: Annonaceae

GIR: Mudzala simba/Mucherere/Muvipo/Mubulushi

Shrub or small tree. Sweet scented flowers. Fruit is green with white marks to 7cm long

Habitat: Evergreen forest, on coral, also rain-forest, evergreen thickets and bushland, Brachystegia, Jul-bernardia thickets, wooded grassland; at elevations from sea level to 900 metres.

The fruit is edible. The leaves and roots are used to treat spiritual ailments
