

Rauvolfia mombasiana

Fam. Apocynaceae KSW: Mti-sumu GIR: Mumasia

A sparse evergreen tree up to 9m. The orange fruit is eaten by birds.

The bark is poisonous and used for rat poison. The root is used for medicine including treating malaria.
