



Thylachium thomasii Gilg
Capparaceae family.

Self seeded. Grown from seed or cuttings.
This plant is often flowering and always covered in Colotis butterflies and ants.

May be a larval food plant for Appias, Belenois, Colotis, Dixeia, Eronia, Leptosia, Nephronia, and Pinacopteryx.

There is no evidence from the coast that this is a larval food plant, but is regularly visited by butterflies, as seen by the Colotis left.
